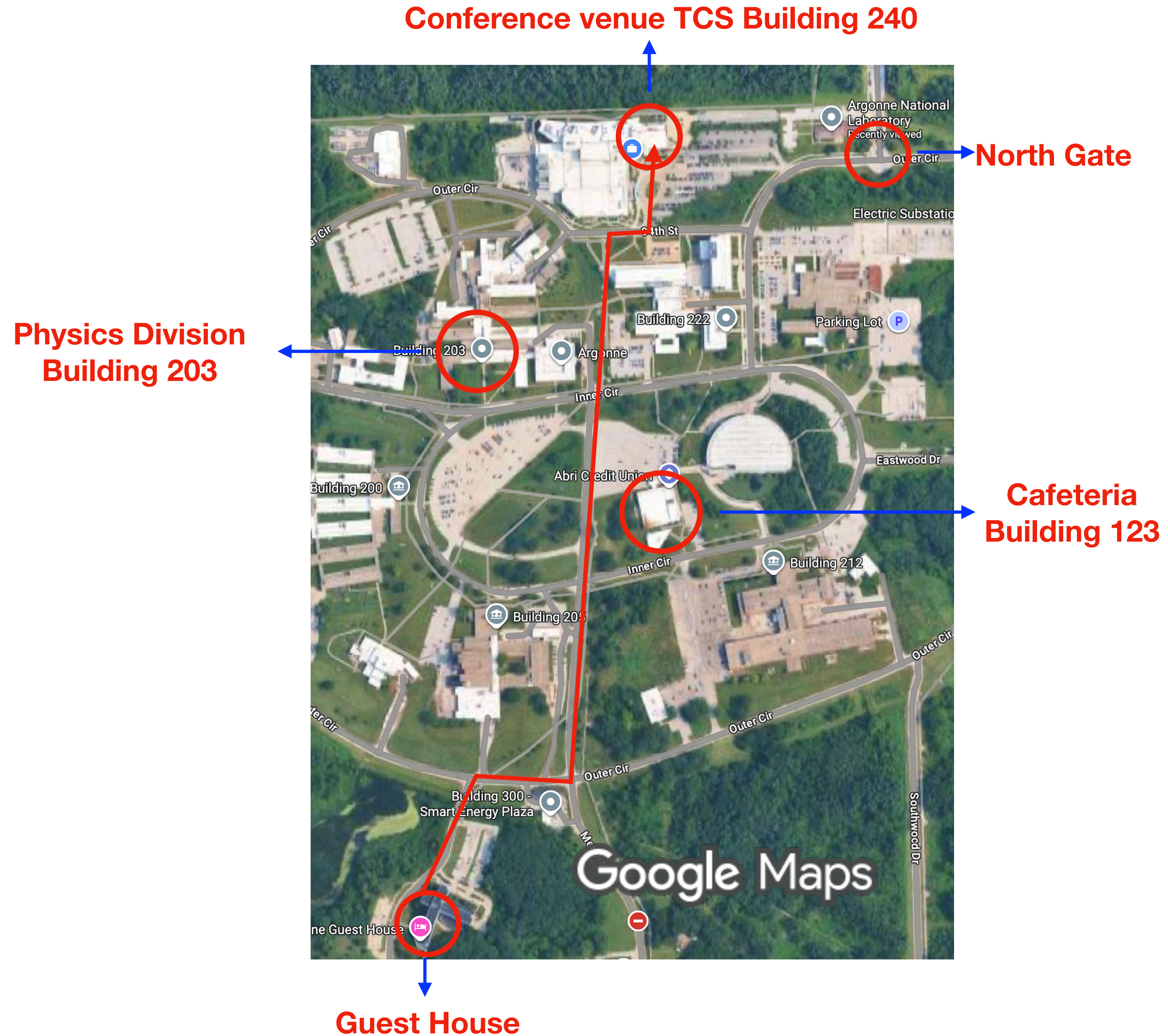

Things to do during free time:

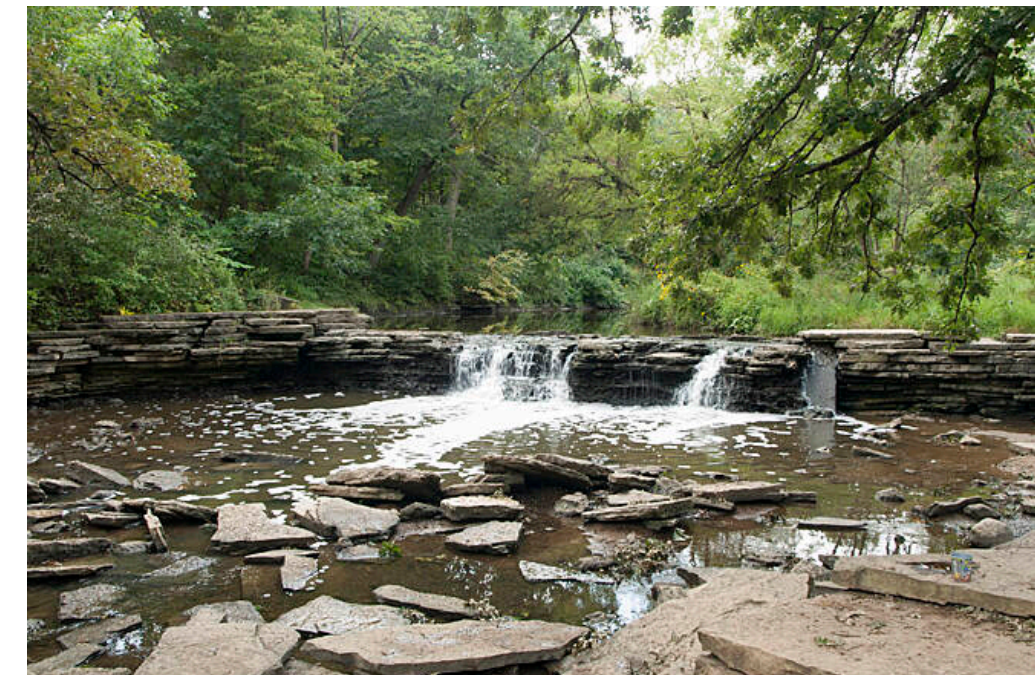
Do not enter any restricted area or building other than the TCS Building (240), Cafeteria and Guest House, unless accompanied by your host.

(During lunch break on April 16, or anytime if accompanied by an Argonne employee.)

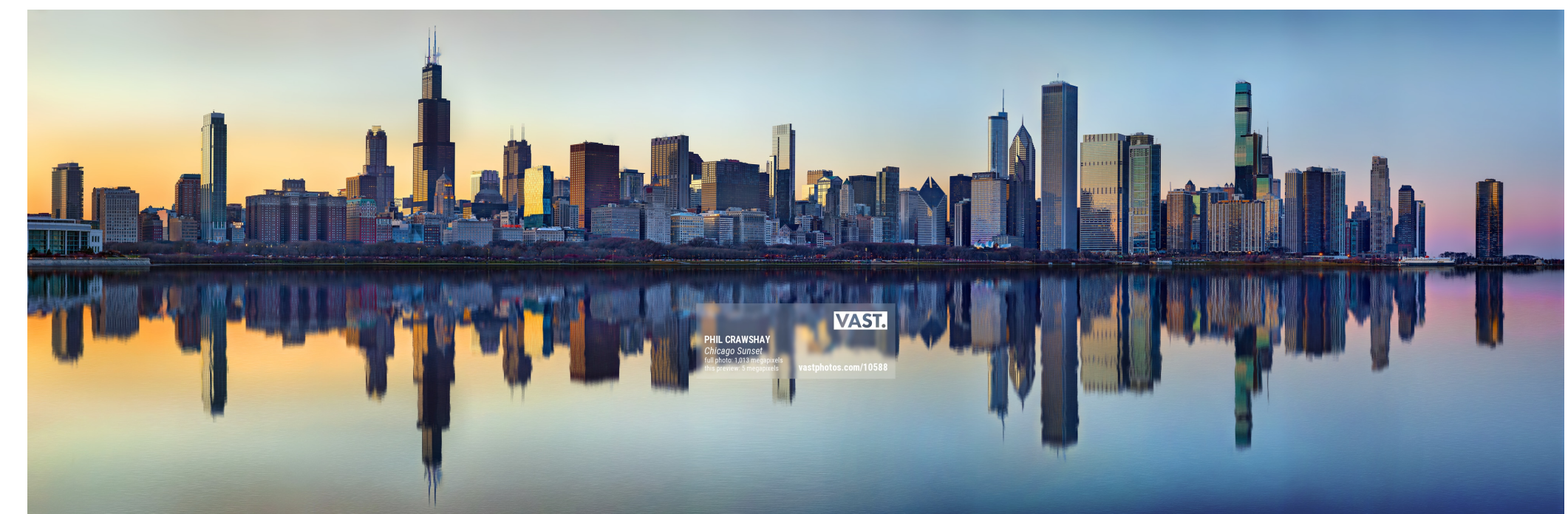


Waterfall Glen Forest Preserve: 11-mile loop around the Argonne National Laboratory. Trail head on Northgate Road.
